Aimed at: Students and graduates from Mass Communication, Journalism, Film and Communication Arts Institutes. Television journalists.

Granted certificates: Proof of attendance to the course and diploma.

Curriculum: Rough definition of the documentary genre and its history. Characteristics of documentary production as a creative interpretation of reality. Exploration of its potential through concrete examples of films that will be screened and analyzed. Training the students through creation workshops that lead to production of documentaries.

The students will participate in class exercises where they put together their film crews and work with cinematography and editing consultants. Screening of documentaries.

The class exercises will involve:

- Creating a character .
- Researching and writing the treatment of a subject.
- Describing an atmosphere.
- Making an interview.
